CENTRICK SIX MONTHS OF PROGRESS

Since taking over in May 2025, Centrick has been transforming our community spaces. Here's an update from the Centrick team...

Winter Works

(December 2025 - January 2026)

Essential tree surgery on Reservoir area and near the linear park will remove dead trees, helping healthy ones flourish. Wood chippings will be retained as sustainable mulch.

Going Green with Transport

Our new electric van arrives in the New Year - a dedicated Hanwood Park vehicle ensuring efficient, eco-friendly grounds maintenance.

Spring Spectacular Coming

Partnering with Bosworth's Garden Centre in Burton Latimer, we're planning vibrant spring planting across the development. Orders finalise by year-end, planting begins March.

Our First Six Months - What We've Achieved:

- Autumn planting completed development-wide
- New fruit orchard near HP office
- Healthier, greener lawns through treatment program
- Wildflower areas established
- 600+ bulbs planted in tree circles
- Regular resident drop-in sessions launched on Tuesdays



We'll supply the bulbs for residents to enhance the open space areas.

PARKING ENFORCEMENT

Following a review of the parking on the development, primarily around Hayfield Cross School and Hayfield Crescent we are implementing parking enforcement from January. There are dedicated parking areas near to the school, with no parking on double yellow lines, except in the 30-minute wait zone. This is to ensure safety of all residents, pupils and parents on Hanwood Park and ensure sufficient space for vehicles accessing the development.

Every great community starts with a spark of inspiration. For Hanwood Park Runners, that spark came from local resident Scott Dinsdale, who had long championed the idea of creating a local running group. When fellow resident Barbi took the initiative to create a Facebook group, she expected just a handful of neighbours might be interested. What happened next exceeded all expectations—a wave of curiosity and community spirit swept through the area, laying the foundation for what would become one of Kettering's most supportive running communities.

Today, the club boasts 400+ members in their Facebook community, with around 10% regularly lacing up their trainers for group sessions. And here's the best part: it's completely FREE to join.

Whether you're taking your first tentative steps off the couch or you're a seasoned marathoner, there's something for everyone. The club offers Couch to 5K programmes, with beginner, intermediate, and advanced training groups. Weekday runs range from 2.5K to 8K, whilst Sunday long runs are tailored to different experience levels.

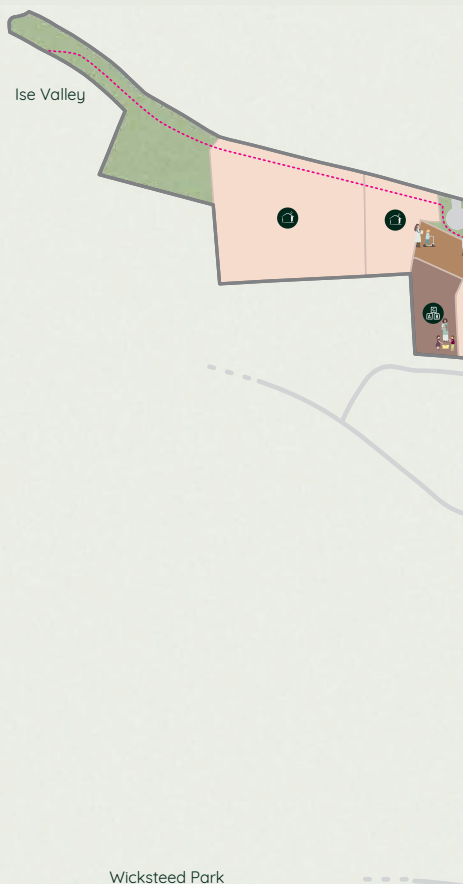

ESTATE UPDATES



MESSAGE FROM CHRIS LANGDON

Project Director

I'm pleased to share that the past few months have seen some fantastic progress right across Hanwood Park and really pleased at the on-going work and contributions from our partners, stakeholders and residents across the board.

Following last December's unanimous resolution to grant planning approval for the remainder of the development, we are now very close to completing the necessary legal agreements to formally secure planning consent for the full Hanwood Park scheme. This marks a huge milestone and gives us the certainty we need to move forward with delivery.

Work is also progressing on the Link Road, which will connect Bertone Manor and Bertone Gardens to East Wood Avenue and Hayfield Crescent with new walking and cycling routes proposed. Detailed design has begun and we hope to set-up a local transport group early in the new year to work with us on improvements to the local movement and transport network.



CHRIS LANGDON

On education, we continue to work closely with the Department for Education and Orbis Education Trust on the planned Hanwood Park Secondary School. We've recently written to our Member of Parliament, Rosie Wrighting MP, to seek her support for the school ahead of the November Budget, emphasising the importance of timely government approval to meet the area's growing needs.

Meanwhile, the Council is pressing ahead with the next primary school using funds collected through the existing Section 106 Agreement, ensuring educational provision continues to keep pace with new homes. We hope to have further updates on this process soon. We've also asked Rosie Wrighting MP to encourage the NHS and Integrated Care Board to work more closely with Hanwood Park to accelerate proposals for a new health

THANK YOU

We're deeply grateful to our residents and supporters for continuing to show such enthusiasm and commitment to the growing community we are creating together. Our thanks also go to the officers and members at North Northamptonshire Council for their hard work and constructive partnership.

With planning consent firmly in view, we've been finalising the first Area Design Code

covering the District Centre. This will guide how new shops, cafés, community buildings, and green spaces are designed and delivered. A big thank you to everyone who has taken the time to review and comment on the draft design code — your feedback has been invaluable and is being collated into the final submission pack, which will be issued as soon as the outline permission is formally sealed.

and wellbeing hub. We know how important this facility is for our residents and remain ready to play our part in bringing it forward as soon as possible.

There's more good news on amenities — planning consent has now been issued for the new David Lloyd Kettering Club. This high-quality health and fitness facility will be a major asset for Hanwood Park, and we expect construction to start fully during 2026. We will share further details as we have them.

On the transport front, we've achieved an initial approval for the A14 Junction 10A scheme, a vital step towards unlocking better regional connectivity. Preparations are already under way for a public exhibition in February 2026, where residents and stakeholders will be able to view the latest designs and learn more about next steps.

With so much progress on infrastructure, schools, health and leisure, Hanwood Park is rapidly becoming the vibrant and well-connected community we all envisioned.

Thank you once again to everyone who continues to get involved through the Hanwood Park Community Trust and consultation events. Your feedback and support make a real difference. We look forward to updating you again soon — and to seeing many of you at our next public meeting later this year.

Exciting progress as groundworks begin on our world-class health and fitness club.

- A multi-use games area and 'battle box' outdoor training zone

In addition to providing exceptional leisure and wellbeing facilities, the new David Lloyd Kettering will create a number of local employment opportunities during both the construction and operational phases, helping to boost the local economy. This exciting development follows extensive community consultation earlier in the year, which saw strong engagement and positive feedback from residents across Hanwood Park, Barton Seagrave, Burton Latimer and Kettering.
