HELPING THE COMMUNITY

The live-saving potential of defibrillators has never been more evident as we wonder at the remarkable recovery of footballers who have benefited from emergency treatment, and read reports about the current pressures on the ambulance service.

We are pleased to advise that there is now a community public access defibrillator (PAD) in place at Hayfield Cross School, which was funded by Hanwood Park LLP.

The cabinet has a key code lock and the code is accessed by calling 999, which means the device is secure and ready to be used by anyone, if needed, 24-hours a day.
